EA project development grant – General (enriching local, pre-university, university) <u>https://ea.ieeer10.org/general-track/</u>

- Selection criteria
  - Project approach
    - Target audience, feasibility of the proposed project, tentative rundown
  - Project engagement
    - Number of participants, OUs, schools, organizations and their feedback
  - Project impact and sustainability
  - Track record of previous EA-funded project completions (Section level)
- Tentative schedule
  - Announcement of grants: 1st Feb
  - Submission deadline: 28th Feb
  - Notification of results: 21st Mar
  - Organizing activities: Apr Aug
  - Reporting and claims for expenses: 1st Sep

Grant mechanism similar to Project 2

Themes:

- Female university students (SDG 5)
- Climate Change (SDG 13)
- Sections from North Asia (Future R10)
- Lifelong learning for members
- Cross-Section



## Details of Projects 2A and 2B

Matching Funding Policy

#### (Matching funding from the Section or other partners is compulsory.)

General track (2A)

- Submission by the Council/Section/Subsection:
  - A maximum matching of USD 600 from the R10 EAC
- The funding is released based on the IEEE Region 10 Matching Fund Policy.
  - A Large Section's project (1501 members or more) will be supported with 50% of the total fund
  - A Medium Section's project (501 to 1501 members) will be supported with 70% of the total fund
  - A Small Section's project (less than 500 members) will be supported with 90% of the total fund
  - A Council's project will be supported with 90% of the total fund

Theme-based track (2B)

- Submission by the Council/Section/Subsection:
  - A maximum matching of USD 1000 from the R10 EAC
- ▶ The funding is released based on the IEEE Region 10 Matching Fund Policy.
  - A Large Section's project (1501 members or more) will be supported with 50% of the total fund
  - A Medium Section's project (501 to 1501 members) will be supported with 70% of the total fund
  - A Small Section's project (less than 500 members) will be supported with 90% of the total fund
  - A Council's project will be supported with 90% of the total fund
  - "Cross-Section" project will be supported with 80% of the total fund



Matching Funding Policy

- ▶ The following are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the matched funding provided by the R10 EAC:
  - Travel and accommodation
    - Except for projects that require land transport from/to rural areas for participating in the project
  - Cash honorariums to guests
  - Cash awards or cash coupons to participants
  - All for food and beverages
    - **<u>Up to 80% of the grant funds</u>** may be used for refreshments for participants in the event as a way to motivate participation and engagement.
- For items that are not eligible for the matched funding provided by R10 EAC, the project team should seek other funding sources (e.g., EAB PECC/EPICS, EdSoc NI, Societies EAC, Section EAC)
